

Cable tray flatness measurement



Overview

The first method for testing a part's flatness consists of laying the part on a CMM marble with a pre-defined flatness. Then, using a feeler gauge, which is made of strips with already characterized thicknesses, we try to insert strips of different thicknesses under the part.
