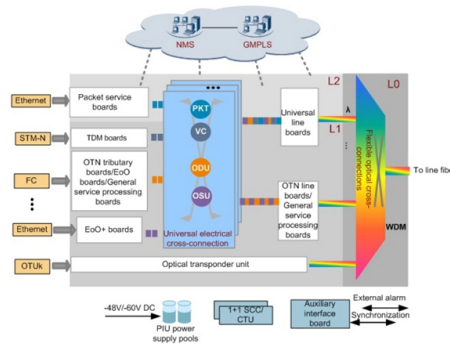

Trays should be installed with correct support spacing, using compatible accessories. Overloading must be avoided, and all bends or junctions should maintain minimum cable bend radius. For runs at an angle of 30 Degrees or less from the vertical, the vertical spacing is applicable. Note: At the point of change from vertical to horizontal and horizontal to. Where products of five metre lengths or above are packed in bundles, they shall be supported with a minimum of three timber bearers which provide sufficient clearance to accommodate the forks of a forklift truck.
