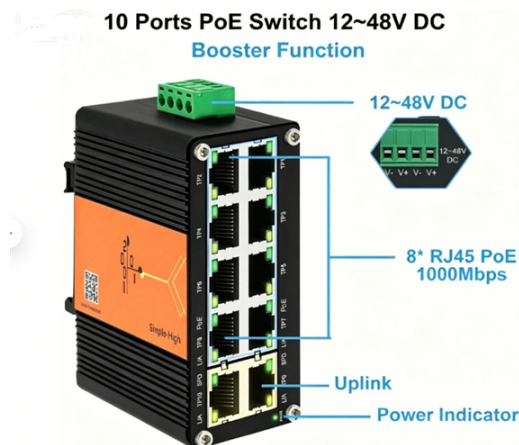


Can power cable trays only be run overhead
