It is mainly utilized in FTTx/PON networks, where they divide a single fiber into multiple branches to support multiple end users, thus reducing the load on the fiber backbone. A fiber pigtail is a short length of optical fiber that comes with a high-quality, factory-polished connector already installed on one end, leaving a length of exposed glass on the other.
