Sagging, or noticeable downward curvature in beams, serve as a significant indicator of structural compromise demanding immediate attention. This phenomenon often results from excessive loads, inadequate support, or material deterioration, leading to beam deformation over time. Hogging is the opposite: the beam curves upward in the middle and downward at the ends. Are any of the properties of the beam, either the split part going to the photodiode, or the part that continues through to the collimating lens, altered in any way (compared to if there was no beamsplitter between them)?
