

Distance regulations for three-level distribution boxes



Overview

Distribution box and switch box should not exceed 30 meters. The Unified Facilities Criteria (UFC) system is prescribed by MIL-STD 3007 and provides planning, design, construction, sustainment, restoration, and modernization criteria, and applies to the Military Departments, the Defense Agencies, and the DoD Field Activities in accordance with USD (AT&L). (1) Power distribution from the primary main distribution board (distribution cabinet) to secondary distribution boards can be branched; that is, one main distribution board may supply power via multiple branch circuits to several secondary distribution boards. Generally, distribution boxes can be divided into three levels of secondary protection, that is, three levels of distribution boxes: general. The employer shall ensure that electrical equipment is free from recognized hazards that are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to employees. Safety of equipment shall be determined on the basis of the following considerations: Suitability for installation and use in conformity with the.
