The correct way to ground and bond a cabling system is to ensure all conductive components, such as cable trays, patch panels, racks, and metallic enclosures, are electrically connected to a single, properly installed ground point. This process needs to comply with recognised standards like BS 7671. When cable protection pipes are accessible, they must be grounded, either by welding to the main grounding conductor or by welding a grounding bolt to the protection pipe and connecting it to the main grounding conductor with a conductor.
