Overview

Answer: The NEC does not have a specific installation clearance, but indicates in section 318-6 (b) that cable trays should be exposed and accessible.

Telecommunications standard TIA/EIA-569 recommends a minimum of 12-inch access headroom above the cable tray. tray shall be grounded per NEC.
