Galvanization is an economical and effective way to protect steel against corrosion, as steel naturally oxidizes when exposed to air, but at a much slower rate than steel. Zinc provides sacrificial protection, which means that it corrodes while. Understanding when tray cables require conduit, and when they don't, is critical for both code compliance and efficient cable installation. Tray cables are multi-conductor cables manufactured and tested to withstand industrial environments. Low voltage systems commonly employ 12V or 24V and serve purposes like landscape lighting, doorbells, and thermostats. These include signal, control, communication, and data cables — rather than power-distribution conductors.
