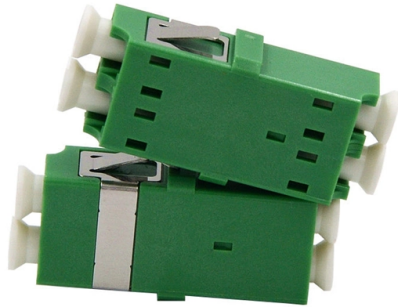


Drainage line size optical cable



Overview

Optical cable is usually placed in a 25 to 40 mm inside diameter (ID) sub-duct which is placed into an existing larger diameter communications conduit. Most communications conduits can be fitted with three or four sub-ducts. Sub-ducts are often referred to as innerducts. FO-VC2 JOINT USE - VERICAL MIDSPAN CLEARANCES 48. FO-RI JOINT USE RISER. Underground cables are pulled in conduit that is buried underground, usually 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to reduce the likelihood of accidentally being dug up.
