

Fire safety regulations for overhead cable trays

The use and installation of cable trays is covered by legally enforceable OSHA regulations in 29 CFR 1910. UK electrical and fire safety standards do not prescribe a fixed minimum separation distance for roof-mounted life-safety cable trays. However, BS 7671, BS 8519, and BS 5839 collectively establish that life-safety circuits must be installed on dedicated containment and be either separated by. NOTE 3: This regulation precludes, for example, the use of non-metallic cable clips or cable ties as the sole means of support where cables are clipped direct to exposed surfaces or suspended under cable tray, and the use of non-metallic cable trunking as the sole means of support of the cables. ucts; however, as an alternative DIN 4102-12 can be used.
