

Guinea Territorial Line



Overview

Guinea has a land frontier of almost 2,050 miles that borders on six other countries. The Guinea-Liberia border is 590 km (367 mi) in length and runs from the tripoint with Sierra Leone in the west to the tripoint with the Ivory Coast in the east. A translation of the Journal Officiel of July 1, 1964, is as follows: -To the south, by parallel of altitude 9°03'18" north, along a distance of 130 sea miles seaward, reckoning from the conclusions of the meetings of the Liaison Committee of National Commissions on the determination of the outer limits of the continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles coordinates of the appropriate points between which the baselines from which the outer limits of the maritime zones mentioned in. The Guinea-Liberia boundary is approximately 350 miles long. It is bordered by the Atlantic Ocean to the west, Guinea-Bissau to the northwest, Senegal to the north, Mali to the northeast, Ivory Coast to the southeast, Liberia to the south, and Sierra Leone to the.
