Grounding is a mechanism to protect distribution equipment and people under normal operating conditions, abnormal operational (overcurrent and overvoltage) responses, and hazardous conditions such as shocks. Grounding is necessary to assure correct operation of electrical devices, to assure safety. The National Electric Code (NEC), Article 250, contains specific requirements on the grounding of electrical power systems and equipment. Grounding is covered in greater detail in HSB's Recommended Practices for Grounding of Commercial. The grounding system provides a low-impedance path for fault current and limits the voltage rise on the normally non-current-carrying metallic components of the electrical distribution system.
