Busbar design in switchgear ensures safe, reliable power distribution by balancing current capacity, thermal performance, mechanical strength, insulation, and standards compliance. A busbar is a metal bar, usually made of copper or aluminum, that carries electricity inside switchgear. They connect the power source (such as the output terminal of a transformer) to various branches (such as the incoming terminals of circuit breakers), acting as a transfer station for electrical energy. These busbars are not merely simple current conductors; they serve as the strategic backbone, interconnecting various components within the.
