

How to match colors for fiber optic splitters



Overview

By adopting the TIA/EIA-598C standard, you gain a universal “language” of colors that speeds identification, reduces miswiring, and enhances safety across cable jackets, connectors, buffer tubes, and splice trays. Connector polish matters! Connectors don't just connect two fibers — they impact performance. The color of the connector boot or body can tell you whether it's single-mode or multimode, and what type of polish (UPC or APC) it uses. Color codes are used in fiber optics to identify fibers, cables and connectors. In the photos above, on the left is a 1728 fiber cable with color coded buffer tubes, in the center are (from the top) singlemode zipcord cable used for patchcords with each fiber color coded, and on the right, a yellow. Summary: Fiber color codes, defined by the TIA-598-C standard, help technicians quickly identify individual fibers, buffer tubes, and connectors in multi-strand cables. Using proper color coding makes installation easier, speeds up troubleshooting, reduces downtime, and supports future network. Originally developed by the Electronic Industries Alliance (EIA) and the Telecommunications Industry Association (TIA), the TIA-598-D standard (formerly EIA/TIA-598) remains the most recognized color-coding system for optical fibers worldwide.
