

How to measure the support structure of cable trays

Cable tray support quantity can be calculated using a simple formula: Support Quantity = Total Length ÷ Support Spacing + 1 $20 \div 2 + 1 = 11$ supports In a typical project, a 20-meter cable tray with 2-meter spacing requires 11 supports. The cable tray's metallic structure and perfect electrical continuity, combined with a high-quality earth network, provides effective defence against electromagnetic interference.

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To assist this selection process a useful approach can be to choose a likely size of tray or ladder and then to estimate the maximum cable weight which is capable of being contained within it.
