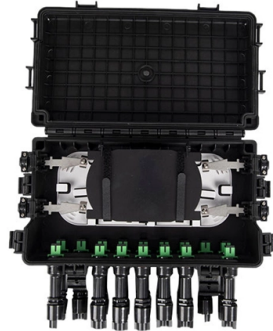


How to read the fiber optic patch panel number



Overview

The cards and ports within a patch panel are numbered starting from the upper left corner at the number 1 position (see Figure 1). Each position number increments by one while moving to the right.
