

Incoming wire dimensions for installing distribution box



Overview

1) Generally, the incoming line of power distribution box adopts five wire system, i. three phase lines a, B and C (generally yellow, green and red), one zero line (light blue) and one ground line (yellow with green stripes). Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1.8m).
① 220V load generally takes one phase line. For distribution boxes that handle only lighting circuits or small power loads, if the incoming wire size is less than 10 square millimeters and the number of circuit switches is fewer than 20, the width of the box should be calculated by summing the width of the switches and adding an additional. The best height for installing residential distribution boxes is 1.8m. The fixing method should be firm and reliable to avoid movement or tilting of the box due to vibration or collision.
