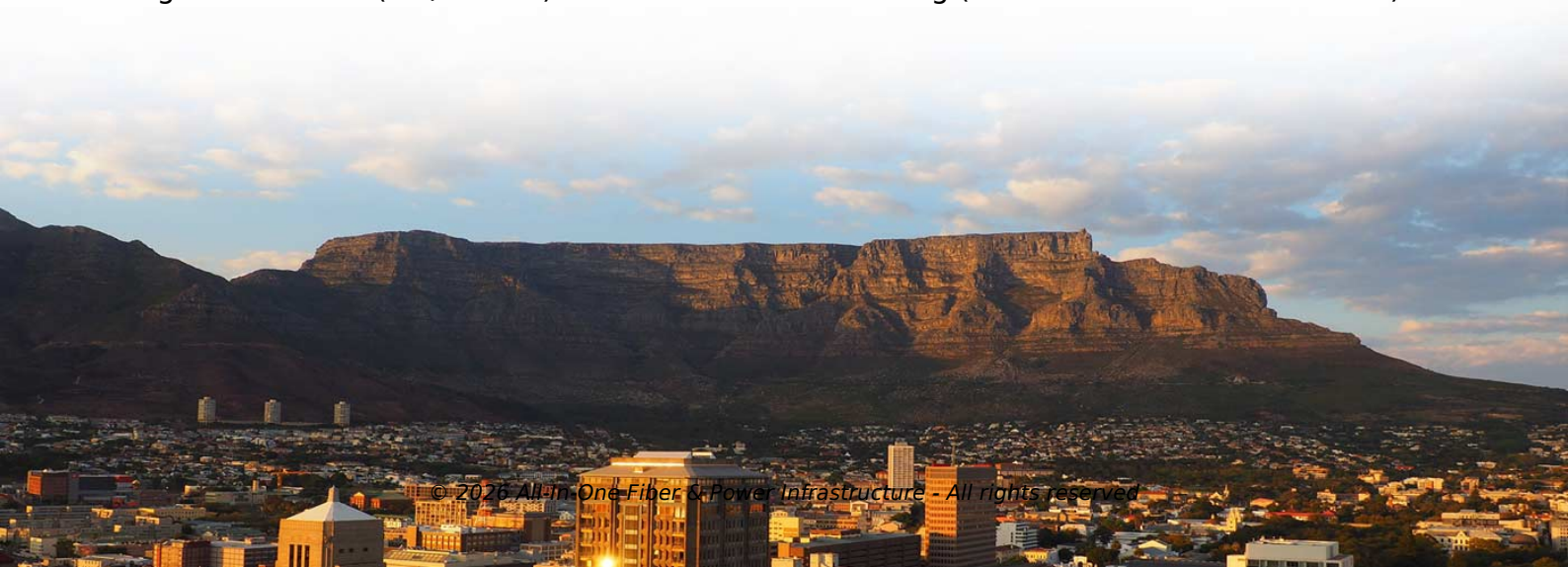


Minimum distance between cable tray and wall

When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0. This spacing is crucial for adequate maintenance access, ease of inspection, and ensuring proper airflow for effective heat dissipation. 8 (Other Mechanical Stresses (A)) in that document provides requirements for cable support. Spacing Standards: Electrical (power) and instrumentation (signal/control) cable trays should maintain a minimum vertical and horizontal distance. Industry standards often recommend at least 300mm (12 inches) of spacing between power and control trays to minimize EMI. Fittings can, on the one hand, be used for horizontal or vertical changing of the routing direction or, on the other, to change the height or width of the. The long and the short of it is that the ratio of the vertical spacing (e) to the external diameter of the largest cable (De) needs to be greater than 4 (i. $e/D_e > 4$) for there to be no derating (see Table 1 of IEC 60287-2-2).
