Grounding is necessary to assure correct operation of electrical devices, to assure safety. Sometimes if I have a 3 or 4-gang plastic nail-on switch box that has a bunch of NM cables, when I'm making up the box rather than using a big blue wire-nut for my grounds I'll separate the grounds into 2 groups and use red/tan wirenuts instead, especially if there's 2 circuits in the box. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
