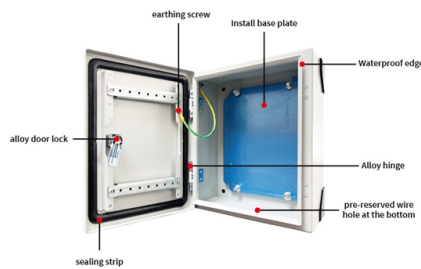


Must cable trays have a ground wire

In cases where mechanical connections alone do not provide reliable electrical continuity. Cable tray grounding wire is the safety connection that links your electrical system's cable tray to the ground. The intent of this article is to review grounding practices for cable tray. An Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC) refers to a safety wire or a metal conductor that transfers the so-called stray electricity back to the power source in case of a problem. When a wire is broken or is leaking power, the EGC captures this energy. ns for completing the grounding connection.
