Code Compliance: Both enclosures must adhere to NEC Article. An instrument junction box is an enclosure housing terminals that allows interconnection between field devices (i. With certain exceptions regulation 526. 4404, AISI 316L), and combined with a circumferential protection channel on the cover opening and a silicone. In those installations, NEMA 4 boxes shall be used.
