

Network patch panel front and rear connections



Overview

An Ethernet patch panel is typically a metal frame with rows of RJ45 ports on the front and punch-down or keystone terminations on the rear. They come in a range of sizes, and are typically mountable, whether that's on a wall, or on a rack to make for easier. OK so I saw that just about all of the tutorials and HOWTOs say that an Intranet Ethernet spider web should connect to the back panel of a patch panel (on the top rack U), then follow-up using switch and PDUs as necessary, but connect the front panel of the patch panel to switches. And. One way of reducing this problem is to have a patch panel at the front of the cabinet and a patch panel at the rear; this way your patch leads can be significantly shorter as well as making it easier to trace cables.
