Overview

For machine rooms, noise is generated by operating multiple machine parts along with the high-frequency rotation of motors, meshing frequency of the gear system, on-and-off brakes, and electrical contact switches to control the elevator. Elevator systems generate airborne and structure-borne noise, and meeting building standards such as DIN 4109 and VDI 2566 requires careful acoustic planning to ensure protected rooms remain at or below 30 dB (A) after reverberation time corrections. Low frequency emissions, especially 80 to 200 Hz. When used in residential buildings, the noise and vibration of elevator operations can potentially intrude on residences adjacent to the equipment. During normal elevator operations several types of noise are produced (drive and brake operation, door operation, relay switching, cooling fan, etc. In high-rise residential buildings (HRBs), elevators run at a high speed, which causes problems such as change of atmospheric pressure, noise, and vibration. Elevator noise and vibration (ENV) of HRBs causes both mental anxiety and a consistently negative effect for promoting a comfortable.
