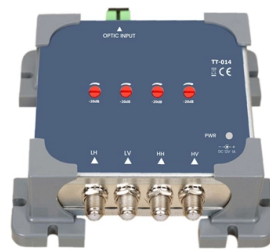


Number of slots for telecommunications fiber optic broadband
