A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require. Cable ladder systems and cable tray systems shall be manufactured in accordance with BS EN 61537, channel support. When the cable tray is erected in parallel with various pipelines, the net distance shall meet the following requirements: 1. The cable reel and the corrosive liquid pipe.
