

Russian Fiber Optic Network Project



Overview

TEA NEXT is a new generation fiber-optic communication line connecting Russian western and eastern borders, launched by Rostelecom. TEA NEXT consists of 96 dark fiber lines available to international operators and global OTT companies for Europe to Asia (Eurasia) connectivity. The cable was proposed on October 26, 2020, by decree of the President of Russia and the. The Polar Express trans-Arctic undersea fiber optic line being created in Russia will become a bridge for Internet traffic between Asia and Europe. This is stated in the Roscongress report. It is emphasized that after the new route is put into operation, the signal travel time will be significantly. Rostelecom which describes itself as “Russia's largest integrated digital company”, has entered into a legally binding parity agreement with VEB Ventures (part of VEB. RF) to acquire a stake in Atlas (or its operating company) to develop a fibre backbone TEA NEXT (for Transit Europe – Asia).
