Standard Residential/Commercial Areas: 24 to 36 inches (60 to 90 cm) deep. Underground cables are pulled in conduit that is buried underground, usually 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to reduce the likelihood of accidentally being dug up. Where plant life, sidewalks, and other utilities already disrupt earth, it's safer to bury at as little as 24 inches or 60 cm, using protective conduits to limit the likelihood of damaged cables by inexperienced maintenance or gardeners.
