

Sealing of cable trays on floors of residential buildings



Overview

Cable trays and busways at floor level or at slab penetrations shall have a waterstop no less than 50 mm in height. Sealing shall be tight and reliable, without visible cracks or. Regulation Group 527. 2 highlights the need for sealing such elements especially where wiring or cable management systems have penetrated the fabric of a building's construction, including floors, walls, ceilings and the like. Many modern forms of engineering construction use Structural Insulated. Scope: Firestopping for busway, cable trays, cables, and trunking passing through walls in enclosed electrical installations. FIRSTO fire stops are developed as a modular system which is simple to assemble around the cable run against the wall or on the floor. Working in inaccessible openings is often cumbersome. Linear joint seals are passive fire protection systems designed to maintain the required building fire resistance across a separating element plus, if and where relevant, to accommodate a defined degree of movement. Linear joint seals can be found in walls, floors and in so called head of wall. They ensure that openings in walls or floors for feeding through electrical, data, coaxial, and glass fibre cables as well as cable support constructions and electrical installation conduits can be sealed so that the fire resistance of the building element is restored.
