Fill Limits: For power cables, the fill must not exceed 40% of the tray's cross-sectional area; for control cables, it's 50%. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material.
