

Substation double busbar connection



Overview

A substation with double-busbar configuration employs two sets of busbars. Each power source and each outgoing line is connected to both busbars via one circuit breaker and two disconnectors, allowing either busbar to serve as the working or standby busbar. In Simple words, a bus-bar is a common connection point or a node for multiple incoming and outgoing circuits such as power lines or feeders. Designing a substation involves not only the visible equipment and ratings but also the less apparent factors—operational. This technical article explains six most common bus configurations used for distribution, transmission, or switching substations at voltages up to 345 kV. Single Bus System: A single bus system is simple and cost-effective but requires power interruption for maintenance.
