The inner sheath in cable is an intermediate protective layer between the internal structure and the outer sheath. It is usually made from materials such as polyvinyl chloride (PVC), polyethylene (PE), or low-smoke, halogen-free compounds. 5 μ m for multimode fiber and 9 μ m for single-mode.
