Overview

Beyond the standard options, we have: 1. Bundled Pigtails: These are branchable fiber pigtails, also known as pigtail bundles. They're constructed with a flame-retardant PVC exterior sheath, an aramid fiber strengthening element, and Corning tight-buffered fiber. Due to their robust structure, they are popular and widely used.

2. Armored Pigtails: People use patch cord to connect two devices, such as a computer and a switch, while a pigtail is to connect a device to a patch panel or other termination point. Patch cords are usually shorter than pigtails, typically between 1 and 5 meters long. Pigtails are longer, usually around 10 meters or more. Patch cords usually have connectors on both ends, such as RJ45 connectors for Ethernet cables. Pigtails have a connector on one end and exposed wires on the other end for termination. Fiber Optic Pigtail have a connector on one end and exposed wires on the other end. Patch cords are pre-terminated with connectors on both ends and are ready to use out of the box.
