

Vertical engineering cable tray spacing



Overview

Support spacing for cable trays must align with the manufacturer's instructions, as outlined in NEC 392. Generally, standard trays require supports every 6 to 10 feet, while heavy-duty, long-span trays can handle distances of up to 20 feet between supports. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material. Proper installation can significantly reduce electromagnetic interference, prevent fire hazards, and improve overall efficiency. The mechanical and electrical characteristics, tests, certifications, overall quality management, recommendations mentioned. A cable riser usually is mounted on the floor as per NEMA Standards Publication VE 2-2001 CABLE TRAY-TO-BOX/FLOOR SPLICE PLATES Figure 4.
