

What cable tray should be used for the low-voltage power supply box



Overview

Ladder cable tray without covers provides for maximum air flow, dissipating heat produced in current carrying conductors. Dust buildup is minimal compared to other types of cable tray, such as ventilated trough or solid bottom.
