SOE signal: sequence of events (resolution not greater than 2ms), record the time of occurrence of events (switch or protection action) one by one in order, this is the sequence of events record. COS signal (non-SOE): remote signal displacement (without time stamp). The widely used United States standard ANSI/IEEE C37. For example, unselective protection operation during a medium voltage network fault will cause an outage for an unnecessarily large number of consumers.
