

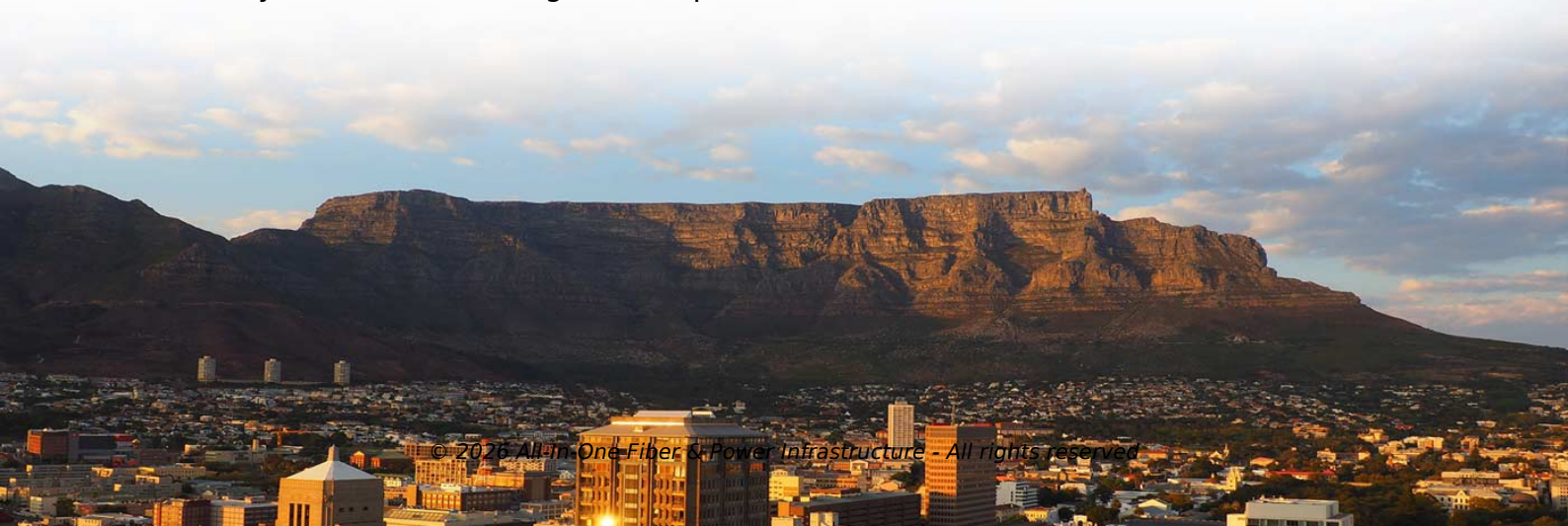
What does light blue indoor fiber optic cable mean
