

What happens if the optical splitter is connected in reverse



Overview

Reverse a splitter to combine signals from different antennas. Splitters contain no electronic devices and don't require any power, making them "passive" instead of "active. " Because of this, they can be connected in reverse without any damage. If i can avoid it I'd rather not buy a powered splitter so what i was wondering is could i use one of these in reverse: So rather than have two inputs and one output (depending on switch position, not combined). Can a coax (TV antenna) splitter be reversed, to feed two antennas into one cable?
