

Why won't the pigtail splice break



Overview

Unlike a patch cord—which has connectors on both ends—the bare fiber end of a pigtail is designed to be permanently spliced (either by fusion or mechanical splicing) to the incoming fiber cable in the field. The most efficient way to terminate a fiber run is by using a pigtail. A fiber pigtail is a short length of optical fiber that comes with a high-quality, factory-polished connector already installed on one end, leaving a length of exposed glass on the other. 0dB loss due to pressure on the cable or over 10dB loss due to a splitter?

It all adds up, and PONs aren't the only thing fiber gets used for. Once the two optical fibers are joined with a splice, they cannot be taken apart.
