Microtrenching is a method used to install conduit by cutting a narrow, shallow trench — usually along the edge of an asphalt roadway. Once the trench is dug and inspected, clean backfilling material should be placed 9 inches to 12 inches deep on the bottom of the trench to provide protection for the cable and to decrease optical fiber
